2. The extended abstract/ paper which is to be presented is based on a research funded by the NSF.
3. The extended abstract/ paper is accepted for
 - Keynote address
 - Invited lecture
 - Oral presentation
 - Poster presentation
4. No. of articles (research and invited reviews) published in the JNSF within last five years*
5. No. of published articles in other indexed journals within last five years*
6. No. of published articles in national/ international peer reviewed journals
7. Having ongoing research funded by the NSF
 - Principal Investigator
 - Co-investigator (in certain cases majority of project research work is supervised/ done by the co-investigator)
 - Research Scientist
 - Research Student
 - Collaborator
8. Having other ongoing research funded by other institutions
9. Receiving partial sponsorship to cover expense.
10. The applicant is a NSF Committee member/ reviewers/ or given his/her contribution to any other NSF task.
