## GUIDANCE FOR CONTRIBUTORS TO EACH CATEGORY

## **SCOPE**

The Journal of the National Science Foundation of Sri Lanka publishes the results of research in all aspects of Science and Technology. It is open for the publication of Research Articles, Reviews, Research Communications and Correspondence.

**Research Articles:** Research Articles are full length papers presenting complete descriptions of original research or technological achievements. They should contain an Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion and should be prepared according to the guidelines for the preparation of manuscripts. Maximum number of words 10,000 including figures, tables and references\*.

**Reviews:** Reviews are critical presentations on selected fields of Science or Technology and should be well focused and organized and avoid general "textbook" style. A person wishing to submit a Review Article should obtain prior approval from the Editorial Board, having submitted a concise summary of the intended article, along with a list of the author's recent publications in the related area. Maximum number of words 12,000 including figures, tables and references\*.

**Research Communications:** Research Communications are intended to communicate important new findings in a specific area of limited scope that are worthy of dissemination among the scientific community. The article should consist of keywords, an abstract, a brief introduction, an outline of the methodology, main results and conclusions. Maximum number of words 3,500 including figures, tables and references\*.

**Correspondence:** Correspondence regarding one or more articles in a recent issue of the Journal including Letters to the Editor, articles covering important scientific events or any other news of interest to scientists, reviews of books of scientific nature, articles presenting views on issues related to science and scientific activity will be considered. Publication will be made at the discretion of the Editor-in-Chief. Maximum number of words 1,500 including figures, tables and references\*.

\* Each table and figure will be considered as 400 words
