





Strengthening access to local literature

SLSI- Sri Lanka Science Index SLSI database currently accommodates 58,056 documents of which online access is provided to the full text over 66% of the items. SLSI database has shown a progress during the year 2018 with an addition of 1,479 records.

SLAAS - Sri Lanka Association for the Advancement of Science The SLAAS database includes complete references and abstracts of **8,558** papers presented at SLAAS annual sessions during the period 1976 -2018. The database has shown a growth of 191 records with the inclusion of information on the abstracts published in the proceedings of the SLAAS, 2018. The database can be searched and abstracts can be downloaded/printed online.


RGRA- Research Grant Database RGRA database currently consist of 2,200 final reports and postgraduate theses produced from NSF funded projects in Sri Lanka. The full text of the research grant reports can be viewed online.

NSLRC Local Databases

SLSTICAT – Sri Lanka Science and Technology Information Catalogue SLSTICAT includes books, monographs, foreign reports, reference tools, CDs & other audio visual materials and consist of 27,739 records and can be access online.





SCOPUS - Citation & Abstracting Database: SCOPUS is a comprehensive information source for literature searches covering peer-reviewed literature in over 22,000 journals from over 5,000 publishers with smart tools that track, analyze and visualize research. It is an ideal source to conduct literature searches. During 2018, 159 local research articles, 9254 citations, and 717 abstracts were downloaded from scopus

TEEAL- The Essential Agricultural Library : TEEAL is a digital collection of research journals for agriculture and related sciences. It provides access to the full text articles in over 450 international peer-reviewed journals from more than 80 major publishers from 1993 to 2016.

HINARI- Access to Research in Health full text journal Database : HINARI together with major publishers provides online access to 15,000 journals and 60,000 e-books in the fields of biomedical and related social sciences.

Strengthening access to global literature

AGORA - Access to Global Online Research in Agriculture: The AGORA program, set up by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the UN together with major publishers, enables access to an outstanding digital library collection in the fields of food, agriculture, environmental science and related social sciences. It covers contents of 13,700 key journals and 26,800 books.


ARDI - Access to Research & Development Information Database : ARDI is a database of scholarly literature which provides free online access to Sri Lanka from diverse fields of Science & Technology. It provides access to 30,000 Journals & e-Books and 100 other Information Resources.

OARE - Online Access to Research in the Environment) : OARE is led by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in partnership with major publishers. It provides access to one of the world's largest collections of environmental science research including 11,500 journals, 27,000 e-books and 40 other information resources

National Digitization Project

National Digitization Project was initiated by National Science Library & Resource Center of National Science Foundation in year 2011 with objective of digitizing 3 million local S&T literature available in 25 research & academic libraries in the country to facilitate easy & quick online access to the full text through a national network of Institutional Repositories developed under the project. Currently **61,062** articles are available to search online and another 22,497 articles are in processing to upload to institutional repositories as at 31.12.2018



There are now 79 journals on SLJOL listing 10271 articles and 1144 issues have been loaded.




Sri Lanka Journal Online Project - SLJOL

The Sri Lanka's primary journal platform, Sri Lanka Journals Online (SLJOL) is a member of the Journals Online (JOL) project established by International Network for the Availability of Scientific Publications (INASP) of the United Kingdom.

Since its inception in 2008 with 06 journals, SLJOL has matured considerably and currently covers 1172 issues of 81 Sri Lankan scholarly journals hosting 10,542 articles.

According to the statistics given on Google analytics in 2018, 204,973 users have been recorded as viewers of the SLJOL and 98,964 full text articles have been globally downloaded from the same.


Subjects Coverage of SLJOL




Global distribution of SLJOL users (Top ten countries)


